# A Guide to Real-name Registration for SIM Cards



Have You Registered?



The Telecommunications (Registration of SIM Cards) Regulation has come into effect.

All pre-paid SIM (PPS) cards issued by telecommunications service providers of Hong Kong need to complete real-name registration within the registration period (i.e. 1 March 2022 - 23 February 2023).

## General Registration Steps

(Please refer to actual and detailed procedures provided by respective service providers)

- Insert SIM card requiring real-name registration into handset, activate mobile data service and disconnect it from Wi-Fi.
- Check the notification sent by respective service provider via SMS message or other means to start the registration procedures. The notification contains the mobile phone number of the SIM card, name of service provider, registration link, etc.
- Input or verify the mobile number or ICCID number of the SIM card which requires real-name registration (some operators may send one-time password for verification).
- Prepare the identification document\*; photograph or upload the image of the original identification document.
- Check and confirm the required information which may be automatically extracted from the identification document and make amendments if necessary.
- 6 Acknowledge relevant disclaimers relating to real-name registration and collection of personal data.
- Complete registration/activation process. Users who have successfully completed real-name registration will receive a confirmation SMS from respective service providers.
  - \* If the user possesses HKID, he/she must use his/her HKID to complete registration.

    If the user is a traveler, he/she must use a passport or other valid identification document as specified in the Regulation.

## Frequently Asked Questions

What if I fail to register my existing PPS cards on or before 23 February 2023? Those PPS cards without registration will be deactivated.

### How can I check whether my SIM card requires real-name registration?

- All new SIM cards issued from 1 March 2022 onwards can only be used after completing real-name registration.
- Existing SIM service plan users need not register again, unless they change to another service provider or subscribe to a new phone number.
- For existing PPS cards in use, service providers will send SMS reminder to users via sender address "SIMREG".

#### How will my personal information be protected?

- Personal information is provided by users to service providers directly.
- Service providers should ensure that the registered information is properly kept and is not misused.
- Service providers should strictly comply with the Personal Data (Privacy) Ordinance (Cap. 486) and the relevant requirements to ensure that users' information is properly kept. The Communications Authority has also issued guidelines, requesting service providers to, amongst others, properly handle and keep users' information in compliance with the Regulation.
